

Activity 2: Roman Herb Garden Card Games

**For these activities you will need a pair of scissors.
Please ask someone before using, and always ask for help if you need it.**

Match Maker (1 or more players)

Directions

- Print and cut out the picture and herb description flash cards.
- Mix-up each group of cards and lay face up on a table.
- Try to match the picture with the correct description.
- You can check your answers on the Roman herb information sheet

Memory (2-4 players)

Directions

- You will need two complete sets of flash cards.
- Mix up the cards.
- Lay them in rows, face down.
- Turn over any two cards.
- If the two cards match, keep them.
- If they don't match, turn them back over.
- Try to remember what was on each card and where it was.
- Watch and remember during the other player's turn.
- The game is over when all the cards have been matched.

Snap (2 players)

Directions

- You will need two complete sets of flash cards
- Mix all the cards up.
- Deal out the cards to each player with the pictures and words down.
- Each player turns over a card at the same time. If the cards are the same, the first person to yell SNAP wins the cards.
- The winner is the person who wins all the cards.
- When you have finished, attach all pages together to make a book. You can use staples, tape, or a hole punch and string, ribbons etc.
- The next time you visit Arbeia, bring your book and see if you can find the herbs in our garden.
